ORDINANCE 2023-6

ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2023-4 AUTHORIZING ATTORNEY PATRICK KASSON OF REMINGER CO., LPA TO REPRESENT THE CITY OF GALION AS CO-COUNSEL IN A PENDING LITIGATION AND TO NOW AUTHORIZE MAC MALONE TO DO SAME, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. 2023-4, approved on January 10, 2023, the City of Galion authorized Patrick Kasson of Reminger Co., LPA to present the City of Galion in a pending litigation; and

WHEREAS, Mac Malone of Reminger Co., LPA will be the attorney serving as co-counsel instead of Patrick Kasson; and

WHEREAS, Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2023-4 currently reads as follows:

Section 1: That Attorney Patrick Kasson of the firm of Reminger Co., LPA is hereby authorized to act and appear on behalf of the City of Galion in any court proceeding, negotiation, or agreement relating to representation under and pursuant to the City's contract with the Public Entities Pool of Ohio.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GALION, STATE OF OHIO:

That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2023-4 be amended to read as follows:

Section 1: That Attorney Mac Malone of the firm of Reminger Co., LPA is hereby authorized to act and appear on behalf of the City of Galion in any court proceeding, negotiation, or agreement relating to representation under and pursuant to the City's contract with the Public Entities Pool of Ohio.

Section 2: That City of Galion Director of Law Thomas Palmer will act at all times as co-counsel in this matter.

Section 3: That to advance the best interests of the city of Galion, and to benefit the health, safety, and general welfare of Galion citizens, an emergency is found to exist and this Ordinance shall take place immediately from the date of its adoption.
