ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SEWER CHARGES FOR CUSTOMERS WITHIN AND OUTSIDE THE CORPORATION LIMITS OF THE CITY OF GALION FOR BILLS RENDERED ON AND AFTER JUNE 1, 2022, REPEALING INCONSISTENT ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the most recent rates established for sanitary sewage treated at the Galion Wastewater Treatment Plant were adopted in Ordinance No. 2014-105, passed December 23, 2014, and proposed rates therefor have been presented to this Council for its review and approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GALION, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That there is hereby charged to each user situated within the corporate limits of the City of Galion, having any active sewer connection with the sewage disposal system of the City or otherwise discharging sewage, industrial waste, water or other liquids, either directly or indirectly into the City's sewage disposal system, the sewer charges indicated as In-Town Rates in the Schedule attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, including sewer only service, which establishes rates effective for bills rendered on and after May 1, 2022, unless amended, all as shown on said Schedule.

Section 2: That there is hereby charged to each user situated outside the corporate limits of the City of Galion, having any active sewer connection with the sewage disposal system of the City or otherwise discharging sewage, industrial waste, water or other liquids, either directly or indirectly into the City's sewage disposal system, the sewer charges indicated as Rural

Rates (Out of Town) in the Schedule attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by

reference, including sewer only service, which establishes rates effective for billings rendered on

and after May 1, 2022, unless amended, all as shown on said Schedule.

Section 3: That any ordinance or resolution, or part of an ordinance or resolution

inconsistent herewith, including Ordinance No. 2014-105, passed December 23, 2014, are, to the

extent of such inconsistency, hereby superseded by the rates and provisions of this Ordinance,

except for sewer usage billed prior to June 2022 and actions taken to collect for such usage.

Section 4: That the sewer rates established in Sections 1 and 2 hereof shall be inserted

at the appropriate place in the current and any subsequent Consolidated Fee Schedule for the City

of Galion as adopted in an Ordinance by this Council.

Section 5: That this Ordinance shall be published in accordance with applicable Ohio

Law.

Section 6: That in order to preserve the public peace, health and safety of the City of

Galion and its inhabitants, and in order to impose the sewer rates established herein for billings

rendered on and after June 1, 2022 without any further delay so as to implement the more current

rates, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately

upon its passage and approval by at least five members of City Council, otherwise from and after

the earliest time allowed by law, after its passage.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GALION, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 2021-114 (Permanent 2022 Appropriations) passed December 14, 2021 and amended by Ordinance No. 2022-3 passed on January 11, 2022, be, and the same is hereby amended as delineated in the following sections:

Section 2: That Four Thousand, Five Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$4,500.00) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 601-8010-52610 Water – Debt Service – Bonds and Notes Principal – Debt Service – Principal Retirement.

Section 3: That Four Thousand, and 00/100 Dollars (\$4,000.00) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 601-8020-52620 Water – Debt Service – Bonds and Notes Interest – Debt Service – Interest Expense.

<u>Section 4:</u> That One Hundred Seventy Thousand, and 00/100 Dollars (\$170,000.00) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 603-8010-52610 Sewer – Debt Service – Bonds and Notes Principal – Debt Service – Principal Retirement.

<u>Section 5:</u> That One Thousand, and 00/100 Dollars (\$1,000.00) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 603-8020-52620 Sewer – Debt Service – Bonds and Notes Interest – Debt Service – Interest Expense.

Section 6: That Forty Thousand, and 00/100 Dollars (\$40,000.00) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 608-8010-52610 Storm Water – Debt Service – Bonds and Notes Principal – Debt Service – Principal Retirement.

Section 7: That One Thousand, Two Hundred Sixty and 00/100 Dollars (\$1,260.00) be transferred from 303-8010-52610 Cheshire Special Assessment Debt – Debt Service – Bonds and Notes Principal – Debt Service – Principal Retirement to 303-8020-52620 Cheshire Special Assessment Debt – Debt Service – Bonds and Notes Interest – Debt Service – Interest Expense.

<u>Section 8:</u> That Five Thousand, and 00/100 Dollars (\$5,000.00) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 235-2010-52326 Health Department 340B Drug Pricing Program – Public Health – General Health – Contractual Services – Advertising.

Section 9: That Three Thousand, and 00/100 Dollars (\$3,000.00) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 235-2010-52450 Health Department 340B Drug Pricing Program – Public Health – General Health – Materials and Supplies – Furniture & Small Equipment.

Section 10: That this Ordinance shall be published in accordance with applicable Ohio Law.

Section 11: That in order to preserve the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Galion and its inhabitants, and in order to make the appropriation adjustments in the Permanent 2022 appropriations without delay to meet pending obligations, this measure is determined to be an emergency Ordinance and shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law after its passage.

WHEREAS, the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), has made funding available through First Responder Wellness, Recruitment, Retention, and Resiliency Grant Program administered by the Office of First Responder Wellness in the Ohio Emergency Management Agency, and

WHEREAS, the City of Galion Police Department is applying for \$139,839.52 and the Fire Department is apply for \$128,217.49 for a total request of \$268,057.01.

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GALION, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That the Safety-Service, be and is hereby, authorized to execute and submit an application in the total amount of Two Hundred Sixty-Eight Thousand Fifty-Seven and 01/100 Dollars (\$268,057.01) to the Ohio Emergency Management Agency, Office of First Responder Wellness for funding from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) First Responder Wellness, Recruitment, Retention, and Resiliency Program; and

Section 2: That the Safety-Service Director be, and is hereby authorized to execute Grant Agreements with the Ohio Emergency Management Agency, if awarded to the City of Galion, and to execute any and all other documentation pertaining thereto.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall be published in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Sections 731.21 and 731.22

Section 4: That in order to preserve the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Galion and its inhabitants, and in order to apply for funds in a timely manner, this measure is determined to be an emergency Ordinance, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of at least five members elected to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption, otherwise from and after the earliest time allowed by law, after its passage.
