**ORDINANCE NO. 2022-74**

**ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2021-114 (PERMANENT 2022 APPROPRIATIONS) BY APPROPRIATING FROM UNAPPROPRIATED FUNDS IN THE AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021 FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF GALION, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 2021-114 (Permanent 2022 Appropriations) passed December 14, 2021 and amended by Ordinance No. 2022-3 passed on January 11, 2022, be, and the same is hereby amended as delineated in the following sections:

Section 2: That Eighty Thousand, and 00/100 Dollars (\$80,000.00) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 268-7090-52317 American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 – General Government – Other Government – Contractual Services – Other Technical Services.

Section 3: That Four Hundred Forty-Six Thousand, Nine Hundred Eighty-Six and 90/100 Dollars (\$446,986.90) be appropriated from unappropriated funds to 268-7090-52505 American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 – General Government – Other Government – Capital Outlay - Infrastructure.

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall be published in accordance with applicable Ohio Law.

Section 5: That in order to preserve the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the City of Galion and its inhabitants, and in order to make the appropriation adjustments in the Permanent 2022 appropriations without delay to meet pending obligations, this measure is determined to be an emergency Ordinance and shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law after its passage.

Dear Local Legislative Authority Official:

Please find enclosed the legislative notice that is being sent to you regarding the applied for liquor permit as captioned on the notice. You must, within 30 days from the "mailed" date listed on the notice under the bar code:

- Notify the Division whether you object and want a hearing; or
- Ask for your one-time only, 30-day extension:
  - Any requests for a one-time, 30-day extension will be reviewed by the Division upon timely receipt. If granted, your additional 30-days runs from the expiration of the original 30-day period.

To be considered timely, your above response must be faxed, emailed, or mailed to the Division no later than the postmark deadline date given on the form.
